## Lesson 9 - Thursday: Eternal Priest in the Order of Melchizedek

- 1. Psalm 110 Most Quoted Psalm in the New Testament
  - a. Jesus (Mt. 22:43-45 also in Mk. & Lk.) David calls the Messiah Lord, showing that He was greater than himself
  - b. Peter (Acts 2:34) deity and ascension of Christ
  - c. Paul (1 Corinthian 15:25) rule and dominion of Christ
  - d. Hebrews 1:13 Jesus's superiority to Angels
  - e. Referenced directly in Hebrews 10:13
- 2. V.1 David overhears a conversation in Heaven THE LORD said to MY Lord,
  - a. LORD = Yahweh / "My Lord" (my Adonai) is not David
  - b. Jesus confirms in Matthew 22:41-45 that this is a conversation between God the Father and God the Son (the Messiah)
- 3. HERE IS WHAT Yahweh said!
  - a. **V.1** "Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool."
  - b. Prophetic picture of Jesus' enthronement following His ascension, victorious, rightful ruler
  - c. Every text showing Jesus seated at the right hand of God alludes to this conversation prophetically confirmed in advance (Matthew 26:64, Acts 5:31, 7:55-56, Romans 8:34, Ephesians 1:20, Colossians 3:1)
- 4. V.2 The LORD shall send the rod of Your strength out of Zion. Rule in the midst of Your enemies!
  - a. The Messiah's reign covers ALL the Earth
- **5. V.3** Your people shall be volunteers in the day of Your power; in the beauties of holiness, from the womb of the morning, You have the dew of Your youth.
  - a. Jesus' followers are volunteers, participating in His mission, because they have seen His beauty.
  - b. Following Jesus' enthronement, He pours out power through the Holy Spirit as the dew covering all who are willing
- 6. NOW the scene David is describing CHANGES
  - a. **V.4** The Lord has <u>sworn</u> and <u>will not relent</u>,
    - Yahweh pledges Himself and His name as absolute confirmation
  - b. "You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek."
    - Genesis 14:18 Melchizedek is the precedent that there is an order of priesthood outside of the family of Aaron and humanity that is both King and Priest
    - Jesus' priesthood is not just different, but better, because Jesus is a Priest forever (Hebrews 7:16)
    - Jesus' priesthood offers sacrifices with power, not just symbols (Hebrews 10:4)
- 7. NOW speaking About the Messiah
  - a. **V.5** The Lord is at Your right hand; He shall execute kings in the day of His wrath.
    - The Messiah is no longer seated in Heaven. He returns to bring His work to completion ("To make your enemies your footstool")
    - The Second Coming has been God's plan all along
  - b. **Vs. 6** He shall judge among the nations, He shall fill the places with dead bodies, He shall execute the heads of many countries.
    - Sin and death will be forever eliminated, because of Jesus' kingly and priestly authority and ministry
- 8. BUT THERE IS MORE!!
  - a. V.7 He shall drink of the brook by the wayside; therefore He shall lift up the head.
    - The scene changes. The Final Judgment concludes / SIN is No More / Death is NO MORE / Violence is NO MORE
    - A Brook To Drink (Refresh) The Battle is Done
    - The Messiah is Refreshed / His Volunteers are Refreshed
  - b. Lift up the head The Messiah (THE HEAD) is Lifted up, Exalted Forevermore
    - And He lifts up the head of His Volunteers: LOOK, No More Sin to be Seen
