Daniel Perrin – Lesson 10: The Last Days – Wednesday September 4: The Great Tribulation

Text: **Mark 13:19-23** – For in <u>those days</u> there <u>will be</u> tribulation, <u>such as</u> has not been since the beginning of the creation which God created until this time, <u>nor ever shall be</u>.²⁰ And unless the Lord had shortened those days, no <u>flesh</u> would be saved; but for the elect's sake, whom He chose, He shortened the days.

²¹ "Then if anyone says to you, 'Look, here is the Christ!' or, 'Look, He is there!' do not believe it. ²² For <u>false christs</u> <u>and false prophets</u> will rise and show signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. ²³ But take heed; see, I have told you all things beforehand.

- 1. What are "those days"?
 - a. How far into the future
 - b. Both Jesus and Daniel (especially chapter 9) blended together the prophetic description of Jerusalem with the experiences of God's people in the distant future.
 - c. Jesus mercifully withholds from His disciples at that time a full picture of everything that will be experienced by His followers, because it would overwhelm them.
 - d. BUT it is instructive for His future followers to see that Jesus had His eye on them and saw a path THROUGH persecution so long before.
 - Those promises would be understood at the right time.
- 2. There was IMMEDIATE tribulation in the Christian era
 - a. First PHYSICAL persecution by the Jews
 - Then by the Gentiles
 - Intermittently by pagan Rome
 - b. Jesus had already directed the minds of His disciples to the prophecies of Daniel (vs.14)
 - Daniel 7 / History / Little Horn / Papal power
 - **Daniel 7:25** *He shall speak pompous words against the Most High, shall persecute the saints of the Most High, and shall intend to change times and law. Then <u>the saints shall be given into his hand for a time and times and half a time.</u>*
 - 3.5 years / 1,260 days, 42 months = 1,260 years
 - 538-1798 persecution at hands of apostate church
 - Persecution of faithful followers of God's Word was intense and thorough
 - If God did not intervene, "no FLESH would be saved..."
 - \circ NO WONDER these martyrs are pictured as crying out for divine justice Revelation 6
 - <u>Parallel texts:</u> 2 Thessalonians 2:3-4 / Revelation 6:9-11 (the cry of the martyrs for divine justice in the 5th seal) / Revelation 13:5-7
 - Luke 21:22-24 For these are the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled.²³ But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! For there will be great distress in the land and wrath upon this people.²⁴ And they will fall by the edge of the sword, and be led away captive into all nations. <u>And Jerusalem will be trampled by Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled.</u>
 - **Revelation 11:2** But leave out the court which is outside the temple, and do not measure it, for it has <u>been given to the Gentiles. And they will tread the holy city underfoot for forty-two</u> <u>months.</u>

- 3. As promised, God intervened and cut that time short for the sake of "the elect"
 - a. Using the Protestant Reformation
 - b. Made sharing faith easier REGIONS and RULERS who were willing to allow differences of faith
 - c. RESULTING in different tactic USED by the great deceiver
 - TROUBLE increases *spiritually*
 - This is why Daniel 12:1 can say about the end times AFTER 1798 "At that time Michael shall stand up, The great prince who stands watch over the sons of your people; and <u>there shall be a time of</u> <u>trouble</u>, such as never was since there was a nation, even to that time. And at that time your people shall be delivered, every one who is found written in the book.
- 4. This time of Trouble is not brute physical manipulation
 - a. FALSE Prophets
 - Didn't say NO prophets. / Didn't say IGNORE all prophets
 - You are going to have to be Discriminating Selective Based on Scripture
 - Joel 2:28-29 PREDICTED prophets
 - b. FALSE signs and wonders
 - Claims of spiritual enlightenment
 - Claims of being led by God
 - Claims of spiritual leadership
 - CUNNING / CAMOUFLAGED in Spiritual Language & Emotions
 - Submit EVERY emotion to Scripture
 - Christians at the time of the Laodicean Church need God's eyesalve (chastening) to help us SEE the way God sees (Revelation 3:18)
- 5. "...I have told you these things beforehand."

Joel 2:28-29 – "And it shall come to pass afterward that I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions.²⁹ And also on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days.

From the destruction of Jerusalem, Christ passed on rapidly to the greater event, the last link in the chain of this earth's history,—the coming of the Son of God in majesty and glory. Between these two events, there lay open to Christ's view long centuries of darkness, centuries for His church marked with blood and tears and agony. Upon these scenes His disciples could not then endure to look, and Jesus passed them by with a brief mention. "Then shall be great tribulation," He said, "such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be. And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened." For more than a thousand years such persecution as the world had never before known was to come upon Christ's followers. Millions upon millions of His faithful witnesses were to be slain. Had not God's hand been stretched out to preserve His people, all would have perished. "But for the elect's sake," He said, "those days shall be shortened."

Now, in unmistakable language, our Lord speaks of His second coming, and He gives warning of dangers to precede His advent to the world. "If any man shall say unto you, Lo, here is Christ, or there; believe it not. For there shall arise false christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect. Behold, I have told you before. Wherefore if they shall say unto

you, Behold, He is in the desert; go not forth: behold, He is in the secret chambers; believe it not. For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be." As one of the signs of Jerusalem's destruction, Christ had said, "Many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many." False prophets did rise, deceiving the people, and leading great numbers into the desert. Magicians and sorcerers, claiming miraculous power, drew the people after them into the mountain solitudes. But this prophecy was spoken also for the last days. This sign is given as a sign of the second advent. Even now false christs and false prophets are showing signs and wonders to seduce His disciples. Do we not hear the cry, "Behold, He is in the desert"? Have not thousands gone forth into the desert, hoping to find Christ? And from thousands of gatherings where men profess to hold communion with departed spirits is not the call now heard, "Behold, He is in the secret chambers"? This is the very claim that spiritism puts forth. But what says Christ? "Believe it not. For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be."

The Saviour gives signs of His coming, and more than this, He fixes the time when the first of these signs shall appear: "Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken: and then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And He shall send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other."

At the close of the great papal persecution, Christ declared, the sun should be darkened, and the moon should not give her light. Next, the stars should fall from heaven. And He says, "Learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is nigh: so likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that He is near, even at the doors." <u>Matthew 24:32, 33</u>, margin.

Christ has given signs of His coming. He declares that we may know when He is near, even at the doors. He says of those who see these signs, "This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled." These signs have appeared. Now we know of a surety that the Lord's coming is at hand. "Heaven and earth shall pass away," He says, "but My words shall not pass away."

Innumerable are the erroneous doctrines and fanciful ideas that are obtaining among the churches of Christendom. It is impossible to estimate the evil results of removing one of the landmarks fixed by the word of God. Few who venture to do this stop with the rejection of a single truth. The majority continue to set aside one after another of the principles of truth, until they become actual infidels.

Satan has long been preparing for his final effort to deceive the world. The foundation of his work was laid by the assurance given to Eve in Eden: "Ye shall not surely die." "In the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil." <u>Genesis 3:4, 5</u>. Little by little he has prepared the way for his masterpiece of deception in the development of spiritualism. He has not yet reached the full accomplishment of his designs; but it will be reached in the last remnant of time. Says the prophet: "I saw three unclean spirits like frogs; ... they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, which go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty." <u>Revelation 16:13</u>, <u>14</u>. Except those who are kept by the power of God, through faith in His word, the whole world will be swept into

the ranks of this delusion. The people are fast being lulled to a fatal security, to be awakened only by the outpouring of the wrath of God.

Fearful sights of a supernatural character will soon be revealed in the heavens, in token of the power of miracle-working demons. The spirits of devils will go forth to the kings of the earth and to the whole world, to fasten them in deception, and urge them on to unite with Satan in his last struggle against the government of heaven. By these agencies, rulers and subjects will be alike deceived. Persons will arise pretending to be Christ Himself, and claiming the title and worship which belong to the world's Redeemer. They will perform wonderful miracles of healing and will profess to have revelations from heaven contradicting the testimony of the Scriptures.

As the crowning act in the great drama of deception, Satan himself will personate Christ. The church has long professed to look to the Saviour's advent as the consummation of her hopes. Now the great deceiver will make it appear that Christ has come. In different parts of the earth, Satan will manifest himself among men as a majestic being of dazzling brightness, resembling the description of the Son of God given by John in the Revelation. Revelation 1:13-15. The glory that surrounds him is unsurpassed by anything that mortal eyes have yet beheld. The shout of triumph rings out upon the air: "Christ has come! Christ has come!" The people prostrate themselves in adoration before him, while he lifts up his hands and pronounces a blessing upon them, as Christ blessed His disciples when He was upon the earth. His voice is soft and subdued, yet full of melody. In gentle, compassionate tones he presents some of the same gracious, heavenly truths which the Saviour uttered; he heals the diseases of the people, and then, in his assumed character of Christ, he claims to have changed the Sabbath to Sunday, and commands all to hallow the day which he has blessed. He declares that those who persist in keeping holy the seventh day are blaspheming his name by refusing to listen to his angels sent to them with light and truth. This is the strong, almost overmastering delusion. Like the Samaritans who were deceived by Simon Magus, the multitudes, from the least to the greatest, give heed to these sorceries, saying: This is "the great power of God." Acts 8:10.

But the people of God will not be misled. The teachings of this false Christ are not in accordance with the Scriptures. His blessing is pronounced upon the worshipers of the beast and his image, the very class upon whom the Bible declares that God's unmingled wrath shall be poured out.

And, furthermore, Satan is not permitted to counterfeit the manner of Christ's advent. The Saviour has warned His people against deception upon this point, and has clearly foretold the manner of His second coming. "There shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.... Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, He is in the desert; go not forth; behold, He is in the secret chambers; believe it not. For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be." Matthew 24:24-27, 31; 25:31; Revelation 1:7; 1 Thessalonians 4:16, 17. This coming there is no possibility of counterfeiting. It will be universally known—witnessed by the whole world.

Only those who have been diligent students of the Scriptures and who have received the love of the truth will be shielded from the powerful delusion that takes the world captive. By the Bible testimony these will detect the deceiver in his disguise. To all the testing time will come. By the sifting of temptation the genuine Christian will be revealed. Are the people of God now so firmly established upon His word that they would not yield to the evidence of their senses? Would they, in such a crisis, cling to the Bible and the Bible only? Satan will, if possible, prevent them from obtaining a preparation to stand in that day. He will so arrange affairs as to hedge up their

way, entangle them with earthly treasures, cause them to carry a heavy, wearisome burden, that their hearts may be overcharged with the cares of this life and the day of trial may come upon them as a thief.
