## Daniel Perrin – L13: Images of the End – Sunday, June 22: The Reluctant Prophet

- 1. In the OT stories, we find the outline of future events for God's people AND the world
  - a. THEY faced the same decisions of loyalty we will face just in their sphere and time
    - The instruction from those stories REVEALS Present Truth for *today*
    - With increased light, the application is clearer and specific to the times we live in.
  - b. In this final lesson we're studying God's attempt to rescue the Assyrian empire in the story of Jonah
  - c. And the Fall of Babylon
  - d. The <u>Memory Text comes from Jonah 1:9</u>: "So he said to them, 'I am a Hebrew; and I fear the LORD, the God of heaven, who made the sea and the dry land' ".
- 2. Jonah: the Reluctant END-TIME Prophet
  - a. How was Jonah an end-time prophet?
  - b. When Jonah *finally* started preaching, the Ninevite <u>families</u> had just 40 days to destruction (less than a month and a half).
    - Nineveh's cup of iniquity was full, and they needed to be warned...NOW.
    - Because God loved the people in that city
    - TIME WAS SHORT And Jonah wasted precious time.
- 3. WE have Jonah's mission and message TODAY!
  - a. Time is short / The cities must be warned!
  - b. What would you think of a physician who won't tell a patient they needed to get their affairs in order because time was running out?
  - c. We have a serious message that we are instructed to tell the world.
  - d. NOT just to discuss in Sabbath School class
- 4. Reluctant means: Hesitating to commit / Slow to get on board / Looking for an excuse or objection
  - a. From the moment Jonah boarded that ship sailing in the opposite direction AWAY from Nineveh...
    - ... He moved from the RELUCTANT category .... To the REBELLIOUS category
    - This is the natural movement of Reluctant (Lukewarm Objects). Lukewarm turn to "Cold"
      - Reluctant Laodiceans end up finally as rebels
  - b. If we are unfamiliar with true compassion for the lost  $\ldots$ 
    - ... we will have a hard time committing to the warning message to be given when time is short?
- 5. By God's Grace, we don't want to be a reluctant prophet.
  - a. And by God's Grace, we don't want to be a rebellious prophet going in the opposite direction of God's evangelistic mission
  - b. What does that even look like?
    - God's Word and His end-time messenger give clear instructions to "Go To Work" to take the gospel to the cities / to your neighbors / to your family // to not seek comfort or familiarity / to warn the world, "Time Is Short, this earth is soon to be destroyed"
      - Instead, do we go the opposite way by entertaining ourselves with a good movie and popcorn
        - Or a series of TV shows
        - We spend hours researching vacation spots, with 30 tabs open on our phone or computer so that we can compare the best places to go to relax and have some fun.
      - But when it comes to visiting our neighbors and talking to them about spiritual things, do we invest the same time and energy?
      - IF this refers to us ... Perhaps we need to be thrown overboard from the lifestyle boat we're traveling on
        - Because it's taking us in the wrong direction

- 6. Lesson points out 2 powerful parallels between Jonah and end-time messengers:
  - a. They deal with the Three Angels' Messages and Coming out of Babylon
    - Take a look at those parallels in the lesson very well explained in the lesson.
  - b. I'd like to share 2 more parallels between Jonah and END-TIME MESSENGERS
  - c. End-time PARALLEL #1 If you've not been involved in proclamation before, God invites you now
    - Jonah 3:1–2 Now the word of the LORD came to Jonah the second time, saying, <sup>2</sup> "Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and preach to it the message that I tell you."
  - d. End-time PARALLEL #2 Go throughout the City
    - Jonah 3:3–4 Now Nineveh was <u>an exceedingly great city</u>, a three-day journey in extent. <sup>4</sup> And Jonah began to enter the city on the first day's walk.
    - God desires workers to enter the cities and warn them.
- 7. AGAIN, By God's Grace, I don't want to be a Reluctant OR Rebellious when God says, "Go"
  - a. Story of how God brought my family to 3ABN
  - b. God's current leading to be in volved in God's plan for educating young people to take the gospel quickly into the cities.
    - My family will still be working in God's vineyard on a different shift with a different crew.
  - c. When God calls you to Go which He will, through His strength, say "Yes."
