## Daniel Perrin – L5: The Nations–Part 2 – Monday, April 28: Daniel 2

- 1. Daniel 2 is an amazing chapter of the Bible
  - a. The prophecy is so streamlined, using a few brief images to reveal the future in layers of prophetic complexity.
  - b. It's a divine prophecy BUT then consider who it was given to:
    - God didn't even give the dream to one of His own prophets first
    - God communicated the future to a pagan monarch
      - God is so amazing in HOW He communicates —
      - Here we are 2,500 years later studying the nighttime dream that a king had one night while he was wondering about the future
      - God uses this prophetic dream to reach OUT!!
  - c. But it is more than just a timeline of future events.
    - The prophecy given in Nebuchadnezzar's dream showed "the relationship between His people and the kingdoms of the world."
    - Nor is this simply about learning to recognize and trust God's sovereignty
      - It's about learning HOW TO LIVE among the rising and falling of leaders, nations, philosophies, wars, rumors of wars, etc.
- 2. Let's hear the dream in Daniel 2:29, 31–35 As for you, O king, thoughts came to your mind while on your bed, about what would come to pass after this; and He who reveals secrets has made known to you what will be. .... "You, O king, were watching; and behold, a great image! This great image, whose splendor was excellent, stood before you; and its form was awesome. <sup>32</sup> This image's head was of fine gold, its chest and arms of silver, its belly and thighs of bronze, <sup>33</sup> its legs of iron, its feet partly of iron and partly of clay. <sup>34</sup> You watched while a stone was cut out without hands, which struck the image on its feet of iron and clay, and broke them in pieces. <sup>35</sup> Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver, and the gold were crushed together, and became like chaff from the summer threshing floors; the wind carried them away so that no trace of them was found. And the stone that struck the image became a great mountain and filled the whole earth.
- 3. What could a pagan monarch know about this vision without even consulting God's Word?
  - a. I think Nebuchadnezzar saw some of this significance of this dream BEFORE Daniel even gave the interpretation
    - He had been asking about the future
    - He had an "unforgettable dream" that God had caused him to forget
    - Under the threat of death, Daniel respectfully asks for time to go to prayer meeting with his friends before they kill him.
      - Keep in mind that the vision and its interpretation were given to Daniel after he went to a prayer meeting.
      - This spiritual detail SHARPENS Nebuchadnezzar's attention
  - b. What we notice without even comparing this with other texts in the Bible
  - c. It's HUMAN AND man-made It LOOKS like something from human ingenuity and creativity
    - Nebuchadnezzar sees something that looks like himself,
    - From what we know of our own selves, we are FRAGILE and MORTAL
    - We can be taken down by tripping over a tree root, a snake bite, a bug bite,
    - If he's willing to look closely, he sees something perishable and temporary and it's Himself
  - d. Declining values: gold down to clay -
    - Not just declining wealth but declining WORTH what kind of worth?
    - Human worth / Moral value / Strength of character

- e. It is static. There is no action, except destruction.
- f. It's topheavy wide at the top, narrow at the bottom
  - Gold is the densest material, then silver, then bronze, then iron, then clay
  - This top-heavy structure is perched precariously on a wobbly base crumbly clay mixed with iron
  - The iron doesn't strengthen the clay in fact it weakens its adhesion to form a unified base
- g. In other words, this is FOOLISH CONSTRUCTION
  - Nebuchadnezzar would recognize it in a moment and shake his own head in disbelief
  - This thing is bound to topple —IMPOSSIBLE to continue
    - Yet we plan and carry on as if OUR future is guaranteed.
    - And the savings accounts we are slavishly protecting will be there undamaged somehow
    - This self-destroying statue gives us a clue as to how we should be involved in the politics of human government.
    - We can't prop up a toppling image with our own hands (or money or lobbyists)
    - BUT we CAN work to rescue anyone who needs some help disconnecting their eternal life from the fate of human power-grabbing
  - Jesus communicated the same message of this vision in the Sermon on the Mount -
    - **Matthew 6:19–21** "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; <sup>20</sup> but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. <sup>21</sup> For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.
